(Using a powder puff or soft pillow and a generous amount of baby powder, the Make-Up Artist socks Swingle in the face, leaving him in a cloud of dust. Swingle exits left, coughing and fanning the air.)

WINTER: In five, ... four, ... three, ... *(She holds up two fingers, then one, and finally a "thumbs up" for zero.)*

(The music begins. The entire cast fills the stage. Winter moves to the empty chair in the pit where she sits with the camera crew and supervises.)

- Dance**: Above the ninth measure of the vocal part.

The cast holds the final pose during applause. On the downbeat of Swingle's Introduction, they stand facing stage left in anticipation of Swingle's entrance.)
