All of this excitement is skillfully captured in this fast-paced, highly entertaining showpiece built around James L. Pierpont's classic Christmas tune:

### **NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR**

To keep a sense of urgency and consistent forward motion throughout, light tonguing (especially in the low winds) is important to maintain. The melody should always predominate, and is indicated as such at dynamic levels above the accompanying figures. If a vailable, temple blocks should be substituted for high and low woodblocks in measures 47 through 78. And lastly, if your band has the chops, then by all means, bump the tempo up.
