## NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

"Storm Mountain Jubilee" captures the festive sound of a down-home bluegrass get-together. The melody shifts among the instrument groups, with the low brass and woodwinds supplying the requisite on- and after-beats (to be played short and pointed). At 65, hand-claps enter the second time with the percussion playing twice; additional percussion is suggested (tambourine, etc). The tempo is bright (J = 200, J = 100) and will work at J = 175.
