

Performance Notes

A catch is a round with words in overlapping parts, producing clever or humorous effects. This piece is easy for students to learn and enjoy because of its polyphonic texture and melodic harmonic lines. The singing of rounds is often where we first learn to harmonize, making this piece a springboard to a musical adventure.

Samuel Webbe (1740–1816) was born in poverty and lost both parents before he turned twelve. A determined young man, Webbe educated himself and learned to play the harpsichord. The awards and accolades that he won led to a career in music.

Catch Clubs and Glee Clubs were popular in his day, and Webbe was actively involved in leading and writing tunes for these groups.
