

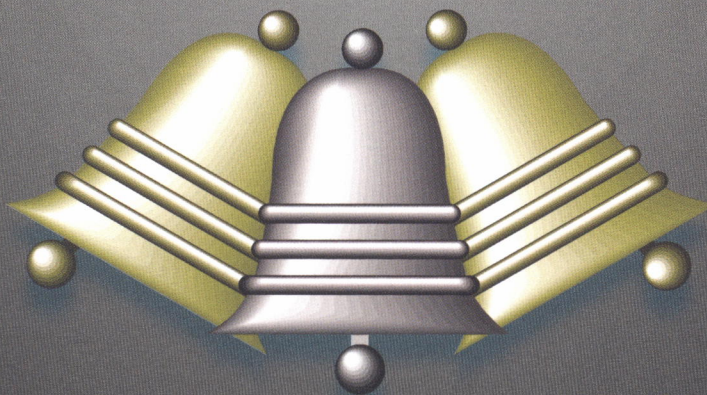

The Boar's Head Carol

For 3 to 5 Octave Handbell Choir with optional Hand Drum, Tambourine, and Suspended Cymbal*

Handbells used: 34, (45), (56)

PERFORMANCE NOTES:

- 3-octave choirs omit notes in ().
- 4-octave choirs omit notes in [].
- 3 and 4-octave choirs omit notes in < >.
- 5-octave choirs omit notes in { }.
- All staccato notes should be rung by mallets on table.
- This piece may be performed as a processional. Repeat the first four measures as needed (C5 should be rung with mallet on suspended bell). Once C3 through G4 ringers are in position, transition to measure 5. Repeat measures 5 through 8 until all ringers are in position. C3 through G4 and tambourine should not play on beat 4 of measure 8 until proceeding to measure 9. Mallet C5 on table beginning in measure 9.
- If not being performed as a processional, omit all repeats.
