

#### **Editor's Note**

Brethren We Have Met to Worship is an early 19th-century American revival hymn, words by George Atkins, a Methodist preacher. As such, it should be sung with the same joy and fervor as originally intended!

#### Performance suggestions:

- Baritones and basses be sure to roll your "r" when singing "brrm", as it should sound like a snare drum.
- Close immediately to the "m" with an open jaw, but lightly closed lips, maintaining resonance instead of nasality in the sound.
- Sing four measure phrases to allow for complete sentences.
- The first two verses should be more percussive and dynamic than the third verse.
- Feel free to slow down the third verse a bit in order to embrace the artistry of the full, a cappella sound as this will impress upon the listener the beauty and meaning of the words.
- If performed with violin/fiddle, the entire song could be sung a cappella, if desired.
